**RE: Camping ordinance revision**

An ordinance to revise the camping ordinance is being sponsored by Council Members Bob Litz and Greg Jamison. The proposed revision will strike the language concerning the 30 day limited stay provision. See subsection (f) of the ordinance:

- (f) No campground may be occupied by the same person or persons for more than 30 days in any one calendar year.

The ordinance also has an emergency clause which will expedite the effective date which is authorized by SDCL 9-19-13. This will make the ordinance effective upon passage and publication.

In addition, City ordinance Section 2-15(b) will allow council to calendar this ordinance under new business as a first reading at tonight's city council meeting. Council will need 6 votes to calendar the item under new business as a first reading. See ordinance:

**Sec. 2-15. Agenda.**

- (b) During consideration of new business, the mayor or any council member may bring before the council any business that person feels should be deliberated upon by the council. These matters need not be specifically listed on the agenda. Formal action on such matters shall be deferred until a subsequent council meeting, except that immediate action may be taken upon a vote of six members of the council.

If council votes to calendar this ordinance under new business tonight, the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading will fall on November 9, which will make the ordinance effective on November 13, 2009.

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS, SD, AMENDING THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY BY REVISING APPENDIX B, REGARDING CAMPGROUNDS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS, SD:

***Section 1. That Section 15.59.154 of Appendix B of the Revised Ordinances of Sioux Falls, SD, is hereby amended as follows:***

***15.59.154. Campground:***

Campgrounds for tents, tent trailers and recreational vehicles should be sited with consideration for access to the property. The campground should be designed to minimize the impact from adjacent major thoroughfares. In addition, the following conditions shall be complied with:

- (a) Each campsite shall contain at least 2,000 square feet.
- (b) The campgrounds shall be supplied with a water supply and sewage disposal facilities, including washing, toilets and similar facilities, all of which meet all applicable city codes and regulations.
- (c) A side yard of 50 feet and a front yard of 100 feet shall be maintained on the campground; provided, however, that the 100-foot front yard requirement may be waived if the front yard abuts on a public street which has a right-of-way width of 200 feet or more.
- (d) The access to public roads and highways shall be paved or surfaced in a similar manner to the adjacent public roads and shall be approved by the city.
- (e) Access roads shall be provided to each campsite and all access roads shall have a minimum unobstructed width of 14 feet for all one-way roads, and 20 feet for all two-way roads.
- (f) ~~Reserved. No campground may be occupied by the same person or persons for more than 30 days in any one calendar year.~~
- (g) Reserved.

(h) All special permits issued under this section are temporary and valid only during the period that the campground and associated facilities comply with the provisions of this title and all other applicable ordinances and regulations.

(i) All campground operators shall keep accurate records as to the length of time a person stays in the campground, and shall make said records available to any city official upon request.

**Section 2.** Pursuant to SDCL 9-19-13, this ordinance is declared necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, safety, and support of a municipal government and its existing public institutions and shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
