ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS, SD, AMENDING THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY BY AMENDING CHAPTER 14 "ELECTIONS" BY PROVIDING A RUNOFF ELECTION THREE WEEKS AFTER THE ANNUAL CITY ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS, SD:

Section 1. That Section 14-85 of the Revised Ordinances of Sioux Falls, SD, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 14-85. Election results.

(a) *Election by plurality.* In election for at large council members and district council members, the person receiving the highest number of votes for that office is elected to that office. If no candidate receives 34 percent to the votes cast in that race, then the top two candidates shall be required to participate in a secondary election which shall be held ~~two~~three weeks from the date of the first election. At the secondary election, the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes at the first election shall be on the ballot. The person receiving the highest number of votes at the secondary election is elected.

(b) *Election by majority.* In elections for mayor, if no candidate in a race involving three or more candidates receives a majority of the votes cast for mayor, a secondary election shall be held ~~two~~three weeks from the date of the first election. At the secondary election, the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes at the first election shall be on the ballot. The person receiving the highest number of votes at the secondary election is elected.
