1. Call To Order

Council Chair Rick Kiley called the meeting to order at 4 p.m.

2. City Council Open Discussion

Council Member Michelle Erpenbach asked for motorists to put down their cell phones, while driving.

Council Member Theresa Stehly spoke about Granny Flats and Tiny Houses being allowed in Sioux Falls. She requested Mike Cooper, Director of Planning and Building Services, come to an Informational Meeting to discuss the matter. Stehly explained the process for an item to be placed on an Informational agenda. Council Vice Chair Christine M. Erickson spoke about the reasoning behind the request process and encouraged items be brought to the Council committees.

Discussion followed regarding: pension trust funding; cost of recent snow event; focus on improving efficiency; compliments to the Public Works team for

doing a good job with snow removal; and appreciation to Turbak for his service.
