1. Call To Order

Council Chair Erpenbach called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

2. Land Use Committee

A. Report on meeting held on Tuesday, October 16, 2012

Council Member Rex Roling stated the items discussed were the vicious dog ordinance revision, the public hearing notification update, and the Shape Places -- zoning ordinance updates. Roling said the vicious dog ordinance will be coming before the full Council in November.

Council Member Greg Jamison inquired about the Urban Agriculture Task Force working session that was held on October 22, 2012. Roling replied that the task force developed guidelines limiting the number of chickens and rabbits allowed to six. If more than the six are requested, this would require approval of 80 percent of the property owners within 100 feet of the subject property. There will be a renewal process involved and reapplication upon the receipt of a citation.

Jamison expressed concerns about this. Further discussion was held on this topic. Roling stated another working session will be held and the meeting after that will allow for public input.

3. City Council Open Discussion

Council Member Jim Entenman stated that he will be out-of-town and unable to attend the Council Meeting of November 6, 2012.
