RESOLUTION NO. 64-15

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS' PROVISIONAL LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES FOR THE 2016 STATE LEGISLATIVE SESSION.

WHEREAS, the City Charter states that the Sioux Falls City Council is the policy making and legislative body of the City of Sioux Falls.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF SIOUX FALLS, SD:

1. That the Sioux Falls City Council, in conjunction with the South Dakota Municipal League, opposes any legislation which would inhibit municipalities from providing services requested by citizens in whatever form the citizens approve and opposes any legislation that restricts local control over taxation and spending.
2. The Sioux Falls City Council supports legislation allowing municipalities alternative publication options.
3. The Sioux Falls City Council opposes any legislation that would reduce, remove, repeal, or reallocate the municipal sales tax, liquor tax reversion, or any other municipal revenues to any other unit of government or that would expand the power to impose a sales or use tax to any other unit of government.
4. The Sioux Falls City Council supports legislation that expands workforce housing opportunities in South Dakota.
5. The Sioux Falls City Council supports permissive legislation allowing a local option drink tax with proceeds funding county government.
6. The Sioux Falls City Council supports cooperative activities between county and municipal governments, the protection of existing joint activities, and elimination of barriers that hinder the creation of such arrangements.
7. The Sioux Falls City Council supports legislation easing county governments' capacity to reallocate existing revenue to fund county operations and state-mandated services.
8. The Sioux Falls City Council supports legislation to allow up to 45 days for award of competitive sealed bids.
